Dzherelo Children's Rehabilitation Centre, founded in 1993, works with children and youth with disabilities such as cerebral palsy, down syndrome, autism spectrum disorder, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, and other developmental disabilities. They are looking to help around 250 children (250 kits) who are part of their everyday program in Lviv, Ukraine, and transport kits to different families.
